

1983 Corvette: The One and Only

Of the forty-three 1983 Corvettes built for testing and development, this is the only one in existence today.

The 1983 Corvette was completely redesigned with some of the most far-reaching changes in Corvette's thirty-year history. Chief Engineer Dave McLellan was charged with finding a way to make Corvette a performance leader again, after federal mandates led to horsepower ratings as low as 180hp.

As McLellan engineered the C4 Corvette toward that goal (which eventually would take Corvette up to 405hp with the ZR-I), many high-tech features were being integrated into the car. Among them was a computer-controlled LED crystal instrument panel; high strength/low alloy galvanized steel for the one-piece uniframe; one-piece sheet molded body panels to eliminate bond seams; as well as magnesium aluminum metals for lightweight corrosion-free chassis and suspension, just to name a few.

With so much new technology going into the car, and new regulations to comply with, the team ran out of time to get the car validated as a 1983 Corvette. This led Chevrolet General Manager Bob Stemple to make the decision to bypass the 1983 model designation.

The pre-production cars were ordered to be disposed of as focus turned to the 1984 Corvette. A mobile car crusher was assigned to the Bowling Green Assembly Plant, and all but one was destroyed.
